

## Guidelines for use of Excess University Scholars/hipards to Purchase/Meal Plansor Dining Dollars

## Introduction

Universityawarded scholarships can be used for any charges on a students obiding as the scholarship description permits Once charges are paid, any excess scholarship a warded duced to the amount of charges. No refunds of University and excession are made to students. This policy applies to University scholarships awarded at the time of admission by the Office of Student Financial Aid after admission private endowed scholarships awarded by the University.

Students whose charges are paid in full and who have excess scho awatiques may use those awards to purchase a meal plan or dining dollars in accordance with the following guidelines:

**Commuter Students** 

Commuter students may purchase a meal plan that is equal to or less than the highest priced commuter meal plan for the semester OR dining dollars up to that amount.

Example: Fall 2024, the Commuter 75/s the largest meal plan and is \$\$25per semester. Commuter students may use excess scholarship awterplarchase this meal plan three may use excess scholarship awartespurchase meal plan and ining dollars up to the amount of \$\$525for the semester.

Students may alsoombine lowerpriced plans along with additional dining dollarsolong as the maximum of \$,525 is not exceeded for the semester.

Residential students may purchase a meal plan that is equal to or less than the highest priced residential meal plan for that academic y@Rdining dollars up to that amount.
